**AMENDED  
ORDER ESTABLISHING VIDEOCONFERENCE HEARINGS**

IT IS ORDERED that all parties wishing to attend hearings shall provide notice to [connect@lamb.uscourts.gov](mailto:connect@lamb.uscourts.gov) via email no later than three (3) days prior to the scheduled hearing. Counsel and parties appearing in multiple cases set for the same hearing date and time may submit a single notice. The court will distribute Zoom hearing details to all parties prior to the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that attorneys must participate via video unless granted permission otherwise.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that parties not represented by counsel who are unable to participate by video may participate in a Zoom hearing by audio after providing notice to the court at [connect@lamb.uscourts.gov](mailto:connect@lamb.uscourts.gov) via email no later than three (3) days prior to the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any exhibits that will be introduced at a video hearing must be served on opposing parties or their counsel at least three (3) days prior to the hearing, and at the same time submitted to the court by email to [orders@lamb.uscourts.gov](mailto:orders@lamb.uscourts.gov). The email subject line must include the case number followed by the word "Exhibits" (e.g., 19-99999

Exhibits). Each party shall combine its exhibits into one pdf document, and each individual exhibit shall be bookmarked.
