BANKRUPTCY STANDING ORDER 2023-1

DEADLINE FOR FILING MOTIONS TO CONTINUE HEARINGS OR TO
WITHDRAW DOCUMENTS AND TO SUBMIT CONSENT ORDERS
FOR MATTERS NOTICED OR SET FOR HEARING

Considering the time required to finalize hearing dockets and notwithstanding the provisions of Local Rules 9014-3(a), 9014-4(a) and 4001-1(g),

IT IS ORDERED that motions to continue hearings or to withdraw documents shall be filed and proposed orders on those motions shall be submitted not later than **12:00 p.m. (noon)** on the second business day before the scheduled hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proposed consent orders on motions for relief from the automatic stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) and/or for adequate protection shall be submitted not later than **12:00 p.m. (noon)** on the second business day before the scheduled hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this standing order shall become effective February 17, 2023.
